

INTERNAL AUDITOR APPLICATION: CERTIFIED HEALTH AND SAFETY AUDITOR PROGRAM

The Certified Health and Safety Auditor Training Program has been developed in response to needs expressed by the Oil and Gas Industry. Pre-audit planning and documentation, interviewing and observation, conducting the audit and post-audit reporting are included in the training. This five-day training course is designed to improve and standardize auditing techniques and skills and is available to students meeting the admission requirements below.

Internal (maintenance) auditors are able to perform maintenance audits only for the company at which they are employed full time.

Conditions

NOTE: Applications should be received two months prior to the scheduled date of the preferred Certified Health and Safety Auditor Course.

At least one of the following needs to be completed prior to registration in the Certified Health and Safety Auditor course:

- The Energy Safety Canada Safety Program Development course
- A certificate, diploma, or degree in Occupational Health and Safety
- A designation as a Canadian Registered Safety Professional (CRSP) or equivalent

Supporting Documents

Letter of Employment: Internal Auditors must be employed full-time by the organization requiring a maintenance (Internal) auditor. The employee may only conduct maintenance audits for the company for which they are currently employed. Attach a copy of a Letter of Employment confirming full-time employment on the next page.

Confirmation of COR/Audit Registration: If the organization has, or is pursuing a COR, you will be asked to upload proof on the next page of the application.

NOTE: Applications that are not fully completed with all supporting documentation will be returned to the applicant for resubmission.
