October 2, 2017 Enform Canada (Enform) and Oil Sands Safety Association (OSSA) became Energy Safety Canada.

Although our name has officially changed, the most important thing to know right now is that we will continue to provide the same training and services, **business as usual**. There are no changes to the current services and program offerings from Enform or OSSA, and all contracts with vendors, Authorized Training Providers, Instructors, and Learning Providers remain in full effect.

This merger brings together the best of both organizations and furthers our common goal of zero worker injuries and incidents. Energy Safety Canada is the new voice of safety for the country's oil and gas industry.

Impact to COR

At this time, there are no changes to COR/SECOR audits and programs, or any other services we provide to industry.

All Enform COR and SECOR certificates will continue to be recognized as-is. Your current COR certificate remains valid as per your audit cycle.

Energy Safety Canada will continue Enform's legacy and be the Certifying Partner for the COR (Certificate of Recognition) and SECOR (Small Employer Certificate of Recognition) program for the oil and gas industry.

Impact to Auditors

There are no changes to the program. Your contracts remain in full force and effect, and will not be impacted by the merger. Energy Safety Canada will continue to be the certifying partner for COR and SECOR for the oil and gas industry.
