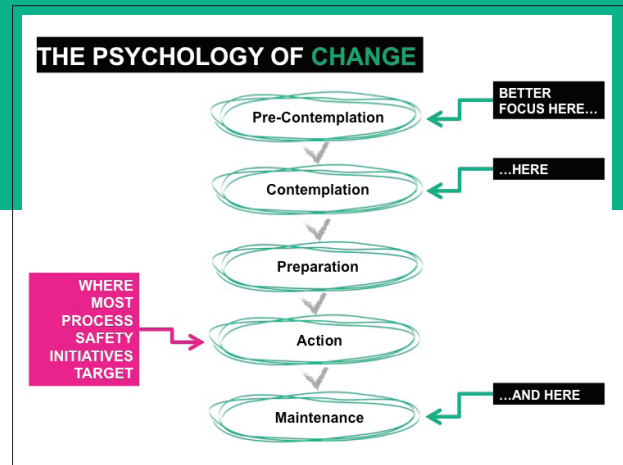

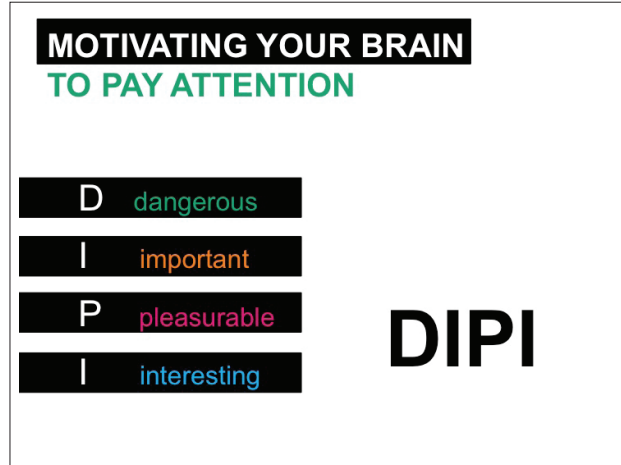

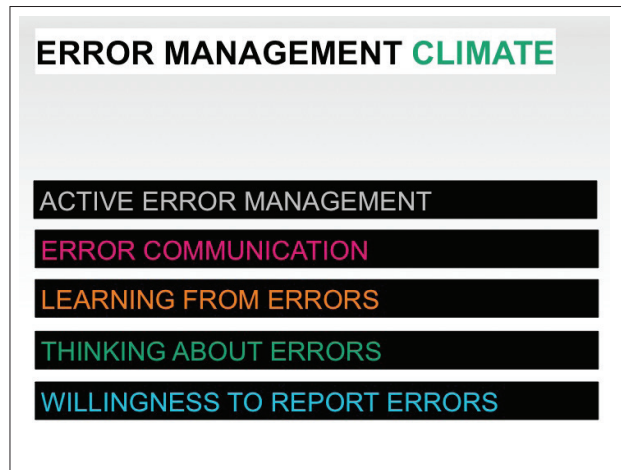

FACILITATE CHANGES IN EMPLOYEE PROCESS SAFETY BEHAVIOR WITH THREE STEPS

1. First, get their attention on process safety and its importance for productivity, quality, and safety



2. Then, focus their attention on seeing, solving, and sharing information about process safety errors



3. Then, keep their attention on their 50% in making process safety work
