



National/International Equivalency (NISE)

The National or International Standard Equivalency (NISE) process allows employers the choice of using a national or an international audit standard, (e.g., OHSAS 18001) to maintain their COR. This is only an option during a maintenance year.

Interested employers should complete the NISE Application Form and submit it no later than June 30 to CORInfo@EnergySafetyCanada.com.

Eligibility

To be considered for NISE, employers must:

- have achieved and maintained a COR for a minimum of four (4) consecutive years
- have obtained a minimum overall score of 90% on their previous recertification audit
- be auditing with an “approved” NISE audit standard (e.g., OHSAS 18001)
- ensure the auditor who conducts the audit for submission under NISE is trained and certified in the audit standard selected
