



## SECOR Assessor Refresher Training Reminder

January is a great month to check your refresher training status prior to submitting your SECOR audit and plan for any refresher course requirements to ensure you stay current. This will also assist in avoiding any delays in your SECOR audit submission and review.

The SECOR Assessor is responsible to attend, every three years, an Enform-approved training course (based on the anniversary date of the most recent required training course). To view your training record with Enform log into My Enform and select My Certifications.

Available courses for SECOR Assessor Refresher training are:

- Hazard Management
- Incident and Accident Investigation
- Introduction to OHS Legislation Training
- Oilfield Driver Awareness
- Safety Program Development

**Who should be your designated SECOR Assessor:** (3.6.1.2 SECOR Assessor Policy) The owner, most senior operational person, or an employee familiar with the overall work operation that has successfully completed the Enform Safety Program Development course. The SECOR Assessor completes the small employer audit each year and submits to Enform for review.
