DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT:

Approximately 1,458 litres of a flammable defoamer product was spilled onto the ground from a pup trailer. The spill occurred from a drain valve during the loading of the trailer. The trailer had just been flushed the previous day using the drain valve.

WHAT CAUSED IT:

The drain valve on the bottom of the trailer was in the open position when filling commenced.

CONTRIBUTING FACTORS INCLUDED:

The drain valve is not easily visible and truck personnel were unaware of its location.

CORRECTIVE/PREVENTATIVE ACTIONS:

- Personnel must secure equipment before and after working on it.
- Personnel must be competent to complete the tasks assigned.
