



Instructions for Registering for the Special Oilfield Boiler Course

To qualify for the examination, “The Power Engineers Regulation” states:

21(1) To qualify to take a Special Oilwell Operator’s Certificate of Competency examination, a candidate must have:

Obtained 6 months experience in an installation that involves a boiler or boilers operating as part of a transportable power plant at a drilling or hydrocarbon production site.

Once you’ve met the above-mentioned qualifications, please follow the below steps to register for the Energy Safety Canada Special Oilfield Boiler Course and the ABSA examination:

1. The candidate/company must send in the fully completed ABSA application for review, to boilers@energysafetycanada.com, at least 21 days prior to the course start date. Please DISREGARD Section 4 of the application.
2. Once the application has been reviewed, Energy Safety Canada will email back with an approval to register.
3. Payment is required at the time of registration and can be submitted via email, or over the phone to Customer Service.

4. 21 days prior to the course start date; Energy Safety Canada will submit all applications to ABSA, on behalf of the candidate, for the exam sitting which takes place in the afternoon on Day 3 of the course.
5. If cancelling a registration after the 21-day time frame, there’s a no refund policy of \$97. If cancelling within 5 business days prior to course commencement, half the course fee, plus \$97, will not be refunded.
