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## BC Provincial Requirements

WSBC continues to require that audit observations be in-person and included in all audits. Auditors and employers may continue to use in-person or virtual document reviews, and in-person or virtual interviews.

## Other Provincial Requirements | AB, SK & MB etc.

Effective January 2023 all audits must include observations.

- Audit Data Gathering (D,I,O)
  - Documentation review and Interviews continue to have flexibility for virtual or on-site data collection.
  - Including on-site observations is a requirement for 2023 audits.
- Auditor Certification Maintenance
  - Auditors in their current 3 Year cycle will continue to only require 1 audit in 3 Year cycle to maintain their certification.
  - Auditors who recertify in 2023 begin a new 3 Year cycle where the maintenance requirements revert to the requirement of 2 audits in 3 Year cycle.
- Student Auditor Certification - Qualification Audit Submission Timeframe
  - Students that have taken the 5-day ESC Certified Auditor Program in 2022 will continue to have up to 1 Year to submit a qualification audit. Exceptions include if they are using the qualification audit to maintain a 2022 COR then it must be completed in 2022.
  - Students that take the 5-day ESC Certified Auditor Program in 2023 will revert back to needing to submit the qualification audit within 6 months of the last day of the course.
- Action Plans in Lieu of a Maintenance Audit (BC does not participate in this program)
  - For employers who complete Action Plans in lieu of maintenance audits the following deadlines remain the same:
    - Application deadline: January 31
    - Preliminary Action Plan deadline: March 31
    - Submission with Deliverables: November 30

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
