Rules to Remember

» Be Aware

- Know your responsibilities
- Respect the animals whose habitat you are entering
- Know what to do in case of an encounter
- Know the applicable regulations

» Take Care

- Dispose of garbage
- Control food and food smells
- Comply with site rules

» Be Prepared

- Dress for the weather and the work you do
- Boots, pants (tucked in), long sleeves
- Carry deterrent (bear spray)
- Means of communication (satellite phone)

Higher Risk of a Wildlife Encounter

At dusk or dawn

Animals are more active at these times

In breeding season or with young

Animals are more aggressive when breeding, and more protective with young

On roadways

Animals are attracted to roads due to salt, food and easier migration routes
